Clubs are FREE programs for **3rd-5th** and **6th-12th** grade girls to join our sisterhood of supportive peers and role models, and use computer science to change the world. Clubs can be hosted in schools, universities, libraries, community centers, or nonprofits. Clubs are led by Facilitators who can be teachers, computer scientists, librarians, parents, or volunteers from any background or field. Many Facilitators have **NO technical experience** and learn to code alongside their Club members with our comprehensive resources and support.

WHAT DO I NEED TO START A CLUB?

- Space to host the Club, such as a classroom or computer lab
- An adult (18+) responsible for leading the Club through the curriculum for ~1-2 hours per week
- A passion for our mission and the ability to foster community within your Girls Who Code Club
- 6th-12th grade Clubs need computers and internet for each Club member. 3rd-5th grade Clubs can be run offline with optional online activities!
