Our **Girls Who Code Clubs** are completely **FREE** programs for **3rd-5th and 6th-12th grade** girls to join our sisterhood of supportive peers and role models and use computer science to change the world.

BECOME A CLUBS COMMUNITY PARTNER

We seek to create partnerships with state and local leaders, school districts, community organizations, library and afterschool networks and colleges/universities to launch multiple Girls Who Code Clubs. Based on thoughtful conversation with your organization, we'll develop a partnership to support and enhance the Girls Who Code Club experience for your students. There are three main types of partnerships:



HOST PARTNERSHIP

If your organization directly supports potential Club host sites (i.e. school districts, library networks), you can become a Host Partner to launch Clubs at multiple locations in your network.

CONNECTOR PARTNERSHIP

If you do not have direct access to potential Clubs host sites (i.e. STEM Hubs, Afterschool Networks), you can become a Connector Partner by spreading the word to your community through newsletters, webinars, events, and more.



PARENT PARTNERSHIP

Parent Partners are large-scale organizations that have smaller Community Partners that exist underneath them. (i.e. State Departments of Education, national or statewide organizations with regional offices).

- Access to up to \$5,000 in grants through our Community Partnership Fund
- Access to a Partnership Dashboard to see regular updates on affiliated Clubs
- Priority consideration for eligible students who apply to our Summer Immersion Program, where available
- Priority access to regional events and field trips organized by Girls Who Code, where available

- Appoint a primary and secondary point of contact to serve as the liaison between their community and Girls Who Code
- Help to promote Girls Who Code programs across high schools, middle schools, elementary schools, libraries, universities and community centers within their network using resources provided by Girls Who Code
